



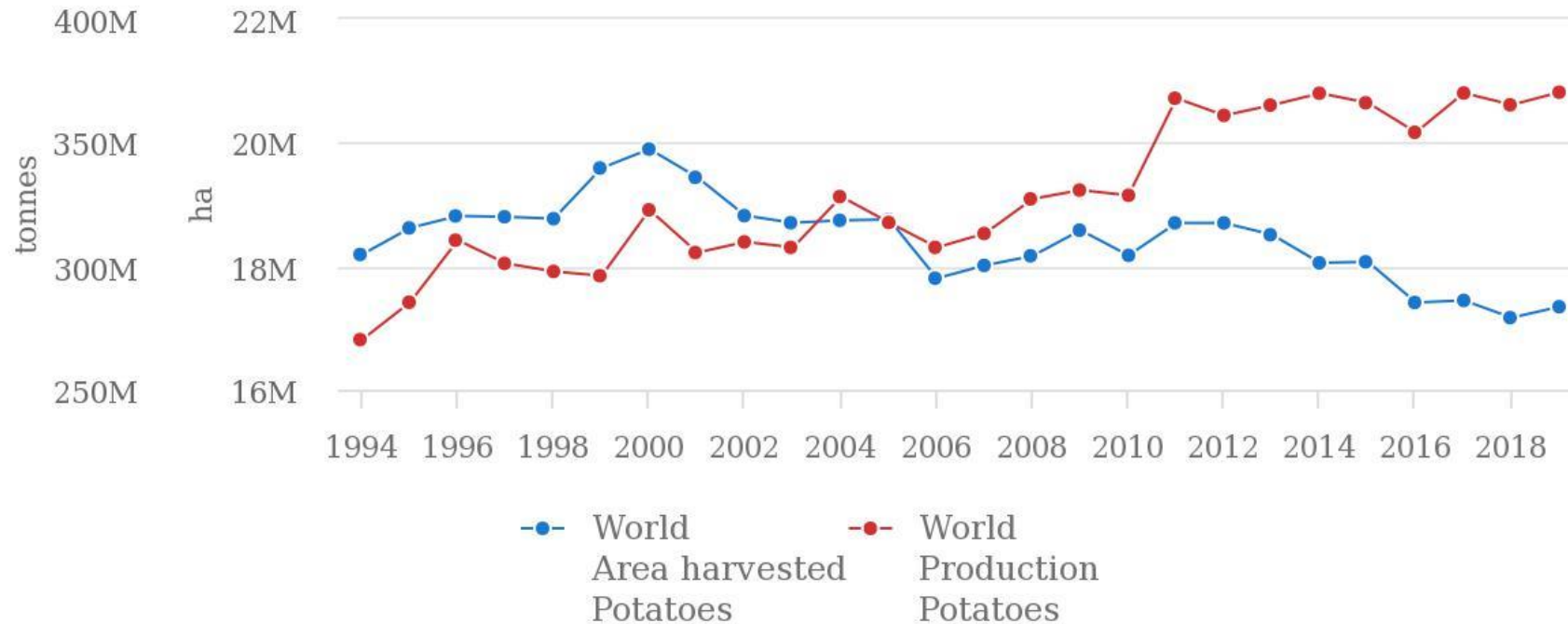

Production/Yield quantities of Potatoes in World + (Total)

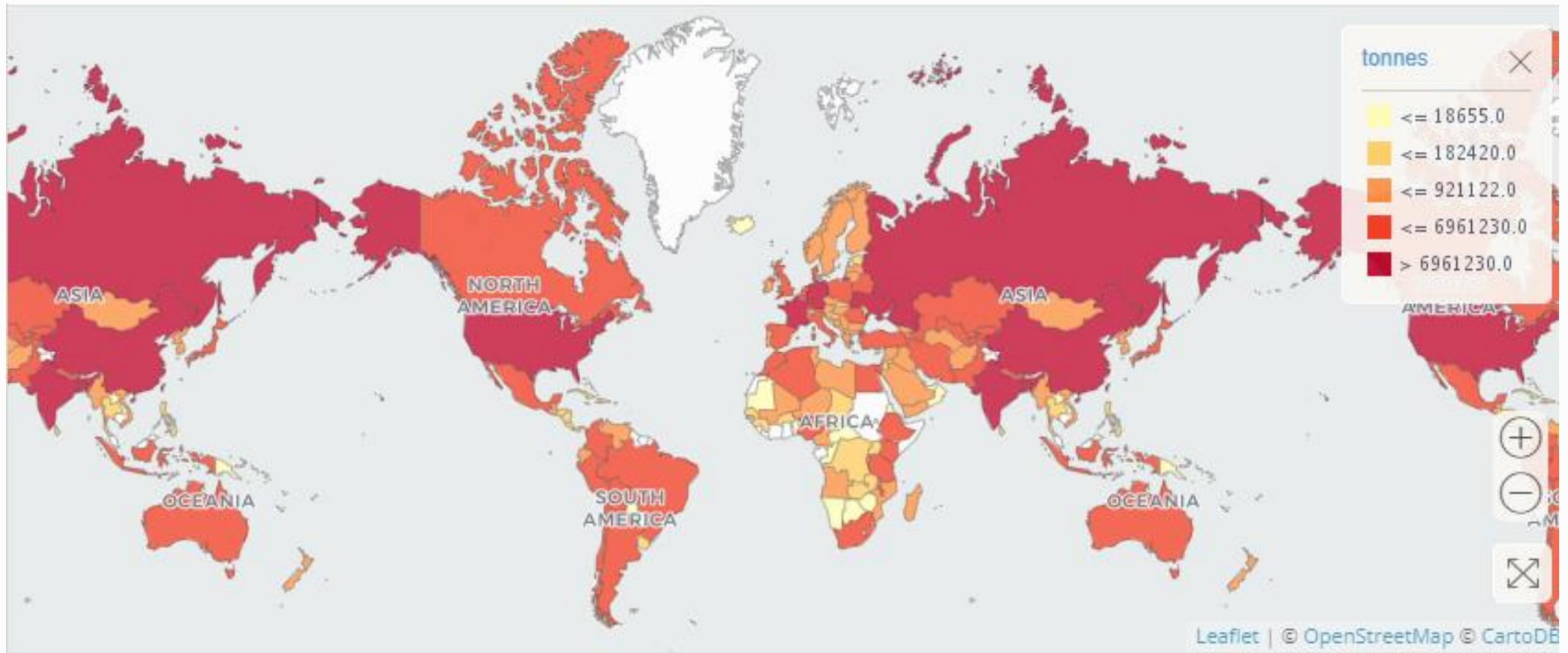
1994 - 2019

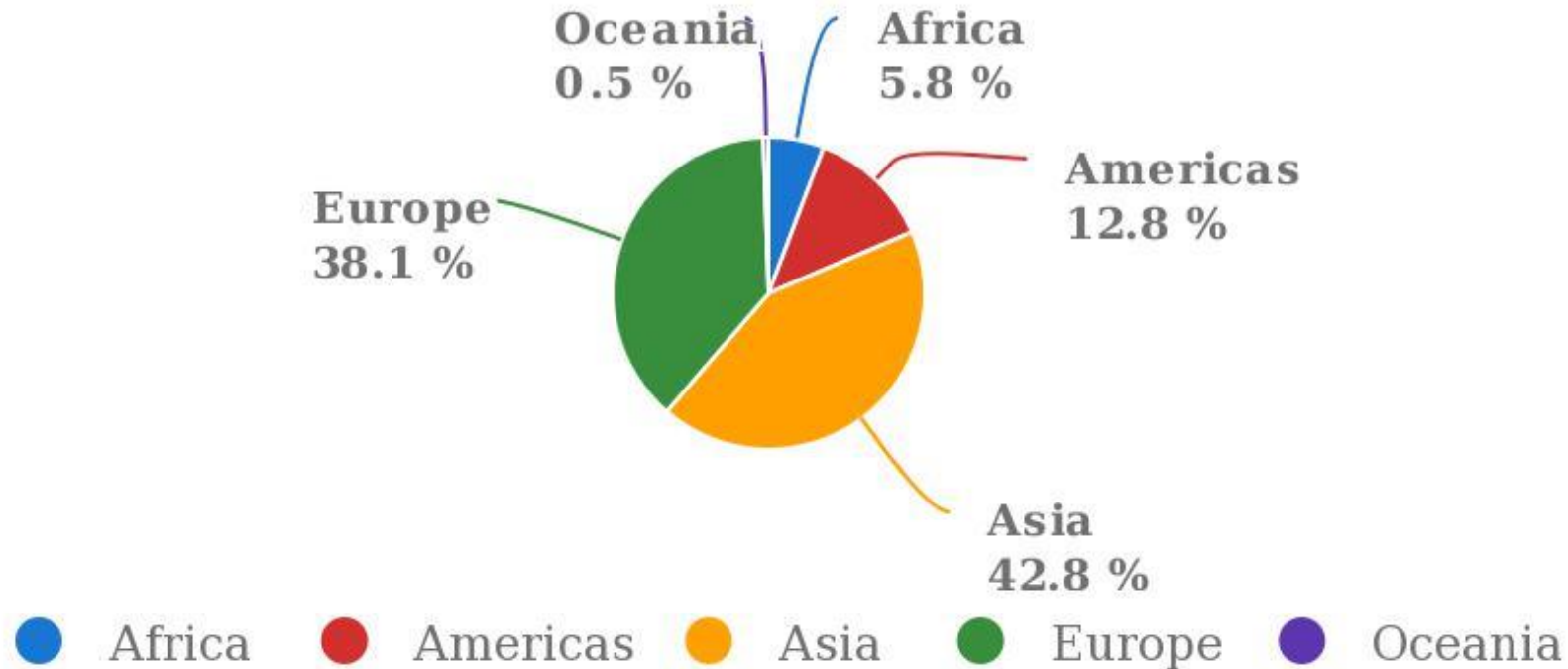

Production quantities of Potatoes by country, 2019



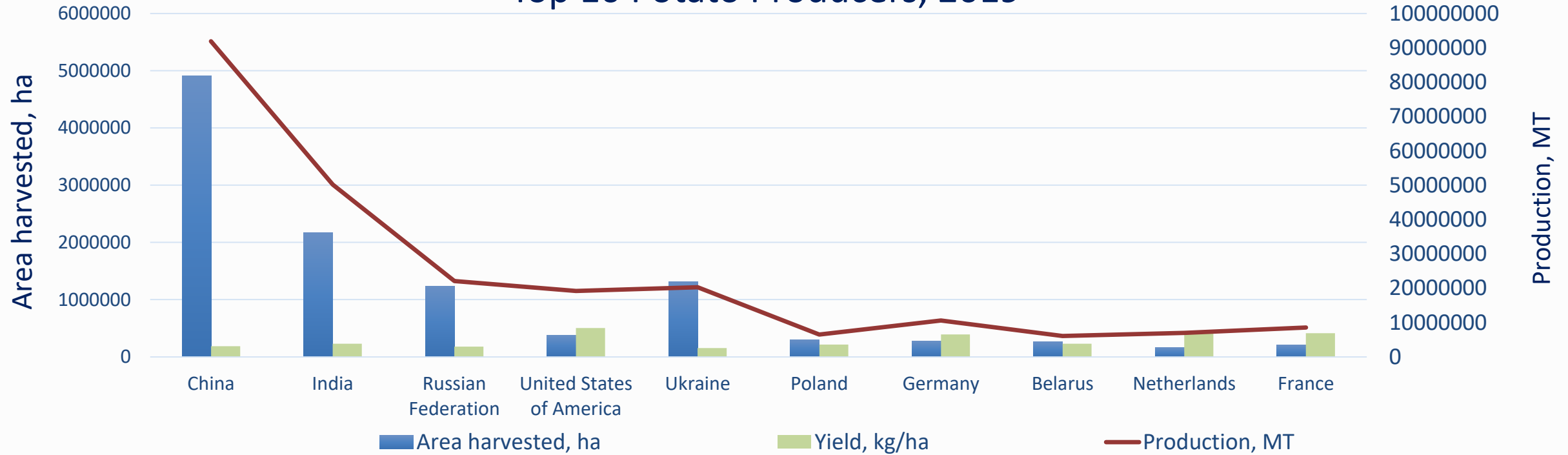
Production share of Potatoes by region

Average 1994 - 2019



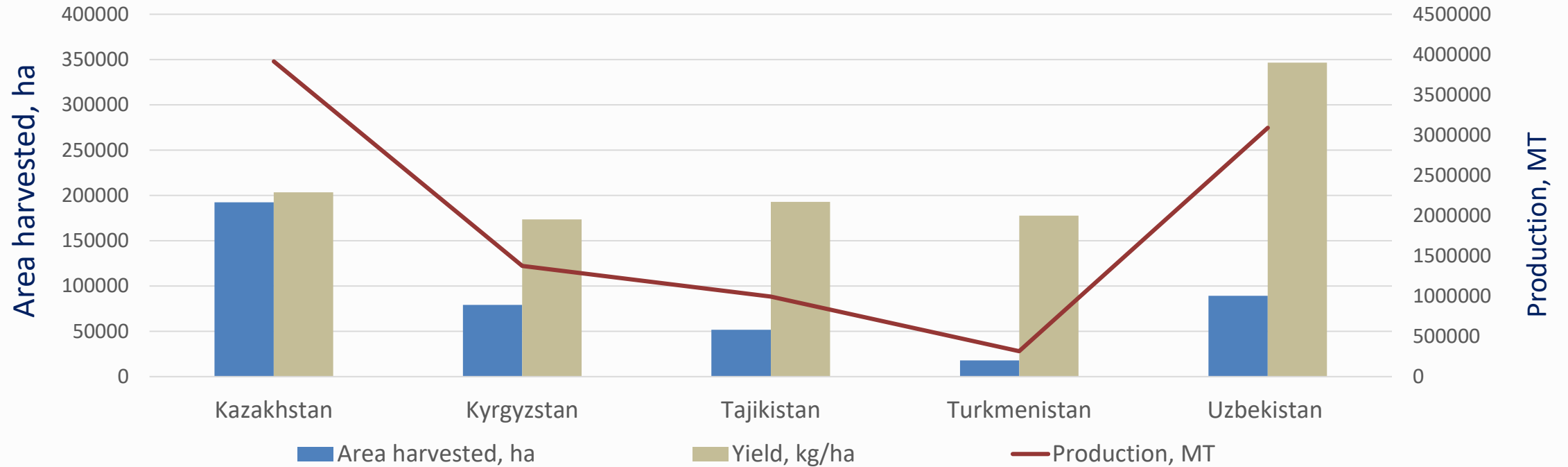
