Project achievements in 2020-2023

- 4 countries of the project are among the top 8 reformers out of 48 economies in Europe and Central Asia as per the 'OECD Trade Facilitation Indicators: Monitoring facilitation reforms up to 2023
- 10 regional meetings of the regional platform of National Trade Facilitation Committees
- 4 Central Asian countries have officially signed a Statement on cooperation in the field of trade facilitation
- 5 Central Asian countries, are interconnected through the digital TIR corridors, effectively reducing transport time and costs for traders
- More than 2100 representatives of public and private sectors from Central Asia built their capacity in trade facilitation







Project achievements in 2020-2023

- Business process analysis conducted at 17 border crossing points and terminals in 4 countries, leading to recommendations for improvement of trade procedures
- 4 digital solutions and innovative measures were implemented at pilot border checkpoints resulted to:
 - 5 border control agencies are connected through 'Sanarip Tamga' information system, facilitating the exchange of preliminary information and data for risk management systems in Kyrgyzstan
 - 30% of additional revenues witnessed by Kyrgyz border authorities during 2-months-testing period for the new Data Exchange Portal between BCPs Dostuk/Dustlik (KG/UZ)
 - 2-fold decrease in border crossing time due to the implementation of the 'E-Transit' automated information system at Uzbekistan BCPs
- 30% reduction of queues for export due to the implementation of the 'E-Navbat' electronic queue booking system in Uzbekistan


